Children's Church at home 22 March 2020

Some activities for Mother's Day, based on the plan for Sunday:

Craft ingredients: coloured paper, coloured card, pens, scissors, Pritt stick, Sellotape.

Ask the children if they remember last week's story. (Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well. Jesus tells her about the living water. Craft was making a well)

Introduction: do you know anyone who's going to have a baby? What is a baby shower? Talk about the excitement of a new baby in the family. Talk about Mother's Day. Is anything special happening today?

Story: Read about when Mary finds out she's going to have a baby, God's baby, and decides to go to see Elizabeth. It's in Lion First Bible P287-291, or you may have a good Children's Bible at home, or here is the Easy-to-Read version (you may need to paraphrase!): 30 The angel said to her, "Don't be afraid, Mary, because God is very pleased with you. 31 Listen! You will become pregnant and have a baby boy. You will name him Jesus. 32 He will be great. People will call him the Son of the Most High God, and the Lord God will make him king like his ancestor David. 33 He will rule over the people of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end."

34 Mary said to the angel, "How will this happen? I am still a virgin."

³⁵ The angel said to Mary, "The Holy Spirit will come to you, and the power of the Most High God will cover you. The baby will be holy and will be called the Son of God. ³⁶ And here's something else: Your relative Elizabeth is pregnant. She is very old, but she is going to have a son. Everyone thought she could not have a baby, but she has been pregnant now for six months. ³⁷ God can do anything!"

³⁸ Mary said, "I am the Lord's servant. Let this thing you have said happen to me!" Then the angel went away.

Mary Visits Zechariah and Elizabeth

³⁹ Mary got up and went quickly to a town in the hill country of Judea. ⁴⁰ She went into Zechariah's house and greeted Elizabeth. ⁴¹ When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the unborn baby inside her jumped, and she was filled with the Holy Spirit.

⁴² In a loud voice she said to Mary, "God has blessed you more than any other woman. And God has blessed the baby you will have. ⁴³ You are the mother of my Lord, and you have

come to me! Why has something so good happened to me? ⁴⁴ When I heard your voice, the baby inside me jumped with joy. ⁴⁵ Great blessings are yours because you believed what the Lord said to you! You believed this would happen."

Mary Praises God

56 Mary stayed with Elizabeth for about three months and then went home. Luke 1:30-56.


