Quiz: What were the Jewish leaders trying to do? What did they ask Jesus? What did he use to give them an answer? Were they happy with the answer? What did they do?

Think: The Jewish leaders were trying to trick Jesus. Do you think that's possible? Do you know the story of Puss in Boots? And Beauty and the Beast? Are there any tricksters in those stories? Do they deserve what happens to them? God loves us so much, we don't have to deserve his love, we just need to love him and follow him. Jesus didn't like the tricksters in the story and he doesn't want us to be tricksters either.

Craft: What are you like? What do you look like? And what sort of person are you? Can you think of 5 words or phrases which describe you? Create a self-portrait using a print-out of you.

Activity: play follow my leader. Take it in turns to lead other people in your family around the house and garden. Go fast and slow, in and out, over and under, mime eating an ice cream or going to sleep ... it could be quite funny!
