## Children's Church at Home 17 January 2021 Epiphany 2

Phillip and Nathanael meet Jesus. John 1:43-51

Craft ingredients: a stone, paints (preferably not water soluble) or porcelain pens.

First: how long does it take to make friends with someone new? A minute? A day? A week? And how long until you feel you really know them well?

**Story**: John 1:43-51

**Think:** When Phillip told Nathanael about Jesus, he said something a bit rude about people from Nazareth. Oh dear! That wasn't very nice, was it? we need to be friendly with everyone, even if we don't feel quite sure about them.

What do you think Nathanael was doing under the fig tree? The video gives the idea that he wasn't doing anything much, except eating figs. But supposing he was really worried or sad about something and was talking to God about it? Maybe he was asking for help. So when Jesus said he saw him sitting there, it was a secret way of saying, I know what you were praying about. And even, I'm going to fix the problem for you. No wonder Nathanael was so excited!

**Craft**: let's put Nathanael under a tree in our garden. When we look out at him, he will remind us that God is always listening to us when we ask him for help. And sooner or later, he will sort things out for us, maybe in a surprising way!

Activity: do you know the game 40 40? You need more than 2 people. Choose a homey. One person covers their eyes and counts to 40. The others go off and hide. when the counter gets to 40, they open their eyes and try to catch the others before they get back to homey. Swop roles and be kind! (There's often one person who is slower than the others.)

Or play boxes. Make a grid of dots. Take it in turns to join 2 dots, horizontally or vertically. If you can 'close a box', put your initial in it. The winner is the one with the most boxes.
